The Public Administration Admissions Committee will begin to **review completed applications as of October 1, 2018 for the Spring 2019 admissions cycle**. Applicants must submit all application materials by the **November 1, 2018, deadline**.

### **Master of Public Administration (MPA)**

The goal of the MPA is to prepare students for leadership positions in the public and nonprofit sectors. This includes positions in government, community development corporations, nonprofit social service agencies, planning and consulting organizations, and activities of private firms in public affairs and public policy areas. Through the MPA program, students build the analytical, management, and technical skills necessary to thrive in the rapidly changing public sector.
